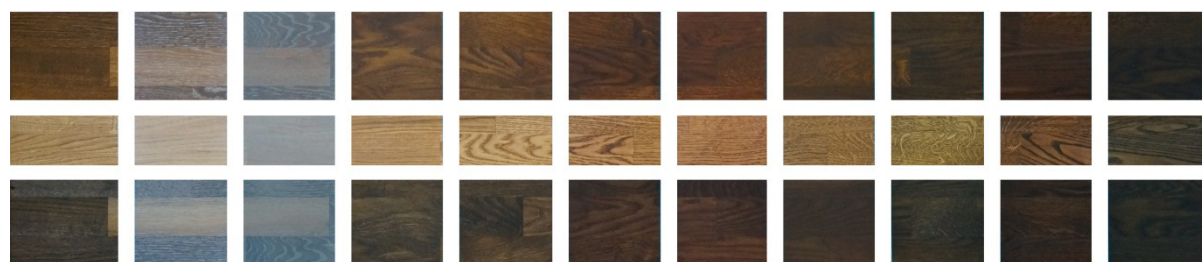
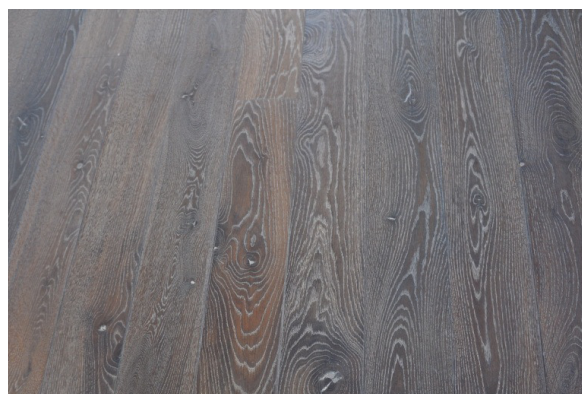

It can be used for creating natural colour effects, such as the look of smoked wood. As a result, lively surface designs are produced: even 3D effects or floors with a rustic, antique look (vintage).

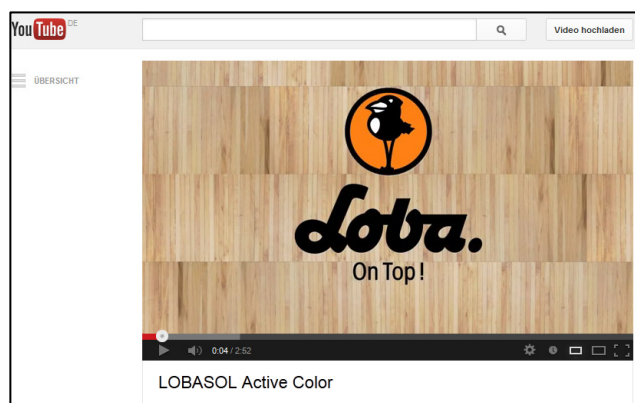
### Simple application, sensational effects

LOBASOL® ActiveColor is available in the colours brown and grey – both accentuate the wood's structure in different and attractive ways. LOBASOL® ActiveColor can be applied with a spray device and the LOBATool Wischwiesel, with a TrimPad or with a roller. The waterborne stain is completely odour-free, can be diluted with water and dries overnight. A video on LOBA's website shows how easy it is to use.

After pretreatment with the reactive stain, the parquet or hardwood floor is coated with LOBASOL® HS 2K ImpactOil for natural and reliable impregnation and slip resistance. A wide variety of customised colourings can be achieved by choosing from the ten different colours of HS 2K ImpactOilColor. The various colours can also be intermixed and/or used in combination with LOBASOL® ActiveColor for countless design options that will amaze interior architects and clients.

The colour of the finished floor always depends on the tone of the wood itself, as well as its structure, porosity, tannin content and sanding finish. It is therefore advisable to create various sample finishes on boards of the original wood until the desired effect is achieved.
